**AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL TITLE VIII, CHAPTER 85, SECTION 85.33
HALLOWEEN “TRICK OR TREAT” VISITS.**

WHEREAS, Title VIII, Public Safety, Chapter 85, Section 85.33 addresses Streets and Sidewalks, HALLOWEEN “TRICK OR TREAT” VISITS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Whiteville, North Carolina that Chapter 85, Section 85.33 Halloween “Trick or Treat” Visits be Repealed.

SECTION I. HALLOWEEN “TRICK OR TREAT” VISITS.

~~It shall be unlawful for any person to appear on the streets, sidewalks or in the public homes, private homes or public places in the city to make “trick or treat” visitations; however, this section shall not apply to children 12 years of age and under on Halloween night. No Halloween “trick or treat” visitations shall be made after the hour of 8:30 p.m. (1991 Code, § 130.01) (Ord. passed 10-22-1985; Ord. passed 10-14-1986; Ord. passed 10-13-1987; Ord. passed 10-25-1988) Penalty, see § 85.99~~

SECTION II. CONSISTENCY. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III. CODIFICATION. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be published as appropriate in the Whiteville Code of Ordinances as soon as practicable.

SECTION IV. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, part of provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then it is expressly provided and it is the intention of the City Council in passing this Ordinance that its parts shall be severable and all other parts of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and they shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION V. PUBLICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.
