RE: SUPPORT PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING OF PROJECT #T-15 SUDLEY ROAD 3RD LANE AND PROJECT #T-46 LIBERIA AVENUE WIDENING

WHEREAS, the citizens of the City of Manassas are affected by transportation issues related to the Liberia Avenue and Route 234 corridors; and

WHEREAS, if selected, City Capital Projects #T-15, Sudley Road Third Lane and #T-46, Liberia Avenue Widening will benefit from House Bill 2 (HB2) funding and from inclusion in the Virginia Department of Transportation's (VDOT) Six Year Improvement Plan (SYIP); and

WHEREAS, City Capital Projects #T-15, Sudley Road Third Lane and #T-46, Liberia Avenue Widening are roadway capacity expansion candidate projects that are eligible for funding through the passage of House Bill 2 (HB2); and


WHEREAS, the passage of HB2 requires a prioritization process to evaluate candidate projects and directs the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) to develop and use a scoring process for project selection; and

WHEREAS, the CTB will review the project prioritization list and will use the scoring, along with other information to inform future funding decisions related to projects in the SYIP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Manassas City Council does hereby support the submission of HB2 applications for City Capital Projects #T-15, Sudley Road Third Lane and #T-46, Liberia Avenue Widening.
