RE: Support for a Change in Scope for Capital Improvement Plan Project T-015
Sudley Road Third Lane

WHEREAS, the City of Manassas received approval for House Bill 2 (HB2) funding in the amount of \$7,400,000 for the Sudley Road Third Lane Project; and

WHEREAS, the short timeframe for Round 1 and the new SMART Scale process requirement resulted in the project scope not being fully assessed; and

WHEREAS, City staff has reevaluated the project and is recommending that the scope of the project be revised; and

WHEREAS, the new scope proposed by staff will provide a greater transportation benefit by extending the length of the proposed third lane, providing more throughput, and lessening congestion without increasing the project cost; and

WHEREAS, the public involvement process is complete and all resulting comments have been addressed, as needed; and

WHEREAS, the City Council understands that the City will be responsible for any cost increases above the \$7,400,000 million and may not request additional funding from the state for any reason for this project; and

WHEREAS, the Virginia Department of Transportation has requested verification that the City Council supports the revised scope before forwarding the request for a change in scope to the Commonwealth Transportation Board for consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Manassas City Council hereby supports the change in scope to the Sudley Road Third Lane Project as recommended by City staff.
