Summary Recommendation

Approve the Resolution proclaiming November 1, 2018 as Extra Mile Day in Park City.

Executive Summary

Extra Mile America is an organization made up of 100% volunteers that are committed to reminding individuals and organizations that creating positive change is not just a water cooler topic; it is being active in going the extra mile. This organization casts a bright light on the “*Extra Mile Heroes*” and change-makers who surround us and who continue to give their best. Extra Mile cities can be found at www.ExtraMileAmerica.org.

The Opportunity

To approve a resolution that supports individuals and organizations who are dedicated to “going the extra mile” in volunteerism and service.

Background

- The idea for Extra Mile Day started in 2009 when Shawn Anderson created the Extra Mile America Tour, a cross country bicycle tour and inspirational outreach event.
- Extra Mile Day has grown from 23 participating cities in its inaugural year to 550+ cities this year.
- Park City has been an “Extra Mile City” for the last six years.

Alternatives for City Council to Consider

1. Recommended Alternative: Approve the resolution

Pros

- a. Individuals and organizations in the Park City community who “go the extra mile” will feel the appreciation and support of City Council.

2. Null Alternative: Do not approve the Resolution

Cons

- a. Park City will not be numbered with the cities that support Extra Mile Day.
