

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EUREKA, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2017-61 DECLARING THE EXISTENCE OF A SHELTER CRISIS IN ACCORDANCE WITH GOVERNMENT CODE SECTIONS 8698- 8698.2

WHEREAS, the City Council of Eureka adopted Resolution 2016-06 on January 19, 2016 declaring a shelter crisis within the City of Eureka; and

WHEREAS, the City, in order to allow homeless persons to occupy designated public facilities, rescinded Resolution 2016-06 and adopted Resolution 2016-15 on April 5, 2016, and Resolution 2016-73 September 30, 2016 which again declared the existence of a Shelter Crisis within the City of Eureka and which both added and deleted designated sites for inclusion in the Declaration; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution 2017-61 on October 19, 2017 amending Resolution 2016-73 to add the property known as the Crowley Property as a site for a emergency homeless shelter; and

WHEREAS, the City of Eureka has identified one additional site known as 205 7th Street, Eureka to be used as a short term emergency shelter during the COVID-19 crisis.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Eureka, California, hereby finds and adopts the recitals above as findings and determinations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,

That Resolution 2017-61 is hereby AMENDED to

1. That the property known as the Crowley Property (APN 019-271-004) remains hereby added as a designated site for Betty's PG&E Village; and
2. That the public parking lot at West Washington and Koster Street remains a designated site for the "Blue Angel Container Village".
3. The the property at 205 7th Street is hereby added as a designated site for Betty Kwan Chinn's Family and Women shelter.
4. That the activities described in this resolution are categorically exempt as defined in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15301 and 15303 of the California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3.
