Summary and/or Comments: This ordinance would provide the City Manager or designee with the authority to permit the temporary use of any city right-of-way (including any street, on-street parking space(s), or sidewalk) for the other than public purposes for a specified period of time. This would permit the City to work with local restaurants and retail establishments to utilize additional outdoor space in order to comply with the Governor of Virginia's order regarding a phased reopening due to the Covid-19 Pandemic. This ordinance is recommended to be approved on first reading in order to allow for implementation when City businesses are permitted to be reopened under Phase One of the Governor's orders.
