SUBJECT: Rural Legacy Easement Monitoring Report 2020 – Dorsey Property

Background:

The County owns 24.8 acres, referred to as the Dorsey property. It is located at 1760 Solomons Island Road, Prince Frederick, MD. The property was purchased with funds from the Maryland Department of Natural Resources' Rural Legacy Program. Consequently, the property is subject to a Rural Legacy Conservation Easement and is monitored annually for compliance by the American Chestnut Land Trust (ACLT).

Each year staff and volunteers from ACLT inspect the property; the recent inspection found that the property was in compliance with the easement. ACLT requires that the landowners review and sign the inspection report.

We recommend that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the Board President to sign the Rural Legacy Easement Inspection Forms.
